Biometric Access System



Leigh Academy Blackheath will now be using a biometric image system for cashless lunch payment.

The biometric recognition system looks at skin patterns on the finger or thumb. During the enrolment process the software captures a digital signature of your child's finger tip or thumb, which is then broken down into data points, similar to reference points on a map. The system then turns these into an alphanumeric string which is then encrypted and stored on the Academy's secure server. As only an alphanumeric string is stored, the system is safe and secure, and would be of no use to anyone except for the purposes for which the system is designed.
