#### Reminder of communication sent on 01/09/2025

As we settle into the routine of the new academic year, we'd like to issue a quick, but important, reminder regarding the end-of-day arrangements for student safety.

To ensure a safe and smooth departure for all, we kindly ask that parents/carers do not park directly outside the academy. Please make arrangements to meet your child a short distance away from the immediate academy gates. This request is crucial given the sheer volume of students exiting the site simultaneously each afternoon; on a typical day, approximately 1150 students will be making their way home. Vehicles parked in this area invariably block essential gateways and pedestrian pavements, creating unnecessary hazards and making it considerably more challenging for students to leave the premises safely.
