Missed Learning

Please ensure that your son/daughter arrives at school **before 8.25am** so that they can be on time for their first lesson at 8.30am to avoid missing out on valuable learning time.

- 5 minutes late per day equates to 3 days of missed learning
- 10 minutes late per day equates to 6.5 days of missed learning
- 15 minutes late per day equates to 10 days of missed learning
- 20 minutes late per day equates to 13 days of missed learning
- 30 minutes late per day equates to 19 days of missed learning

Students who arrive at school late miss out on key parts of the lesson;

- Lesson introductions
- Important instructions
- Key information
- Context needed to understand the topic

This leads to difficulty keeping up with the rest of the class.
