Community Safety

As the evenings grow darker, we ask all parents and carers to support us in reminding students about the importance of community safety when travelling to and from the academy. Please encourage your child to stay alert and aware of their surroundings, particularly when walking or cycling on neighbouring roads. Students who ride bikes should ensure they have working lights and wear appropriate reflective clothing to remain visible to drivers.

Student Equipment - Personal Responsibility

To ensure that all students are adequately prepared for their lessons, we kindly request your support in reinforcing the importance of bringing the required equipment to school each day. We understand that oversights can occur, and we appreciate your cooperation in helping us to address this matter.

Also with the weather changing we recommend that students bring a coat to school. They are able to store in our cloakroom at the beginning of the day if they choose to. Could we request that all coats are named, this really helps us return items to the correct student in the event that they are lost.

Student Awards - Bronze

We are looking forward to awarding our first set of Bronze Awards at the end of module 2, and are pleased to tell you that there are currently 137 students on track to receive their Bronze certificates and lapel badges.

To achieve a bronze award, a student must earn 100+ merits, have at least 96% attendance, have received no more than three late marks since the start of module 1, and have fewer than 20 demerits with no supervisions, suspensions or directions off-site.

We look forward to celebrating the students who've met these high standards in December.

Attendance

As you know, excellent school attendance is one of the key contributing factors in a student's success at school. The government have recently published new guidance on how they will support schools and parents to improve children's attendance through a programme called - Support First. To access some of the new support, please contact your college teams directly, who will be able to help.

Included in the new government guidance are a few changes around holiday requests, absences and fines. These are:

- **Holidays:** Schools are not allowed to approve holidays during term time anymore, except in very rare, special cases.

- **Absences and Fines:** The new rules mean we have to be much stricter about children who miss too much school without a good reason. Missing 5 days (10 half-days) without a good reason over 10 weeks (this could be from holidays, being very late, or other unauthorised absences) could lead to an official warning called a 'Notice to Improve'.
