Student Awards - Bronze and Silver

We are delighted for the students that are reaching the high standards needed to gain a Bronze or a Silver award and we are looking forward to celebrating with them at the end of this module.

The criteria for a student to gain a Bronze award is to have 100+ merits, at least 96% attendance, to have three or fewer late marks, fewer than 20 demerits and no, supervisions, suspensions or directions off-site. The students who achieved a Bronze award in module 2, are now eligible for a Silver award for maintaining the standards shown for a Bronze award and gaining another 100+ merits. Those students who gain a Silver award in this module are eligible for a Gold award in module 6, again for maintaining the high standards of at least 96% attendance, to have three or fewer late marks, fewer than 20 demerits and no, supervisions, suspensions or directions off-site as well as another 100+ merits.
