Please ensure placements are confirmed and submitted by the deadline so they can be approved in time for the placement week. Supporting placements helps us give more students valuable insight into the workplace.</p>
<p>Module 3&4 Bronze and Silver Awards</p> <p>We are looking forward to celebrating with our Bronze and Silver award winners on the morning of 23rd March. The awards are a recognition of the students who have achieved 100+ merits, at least 96% attendance, three or fewer late marks, fewer than 20 demerits and no, supervisions, suspensions or directions off-site. Those students who achieved a Bronze award in module 2, are now eligible to try and achieve a Silver award for maintaining the standards shown for a Bronze award and gaining another 100+ merits.</p>
